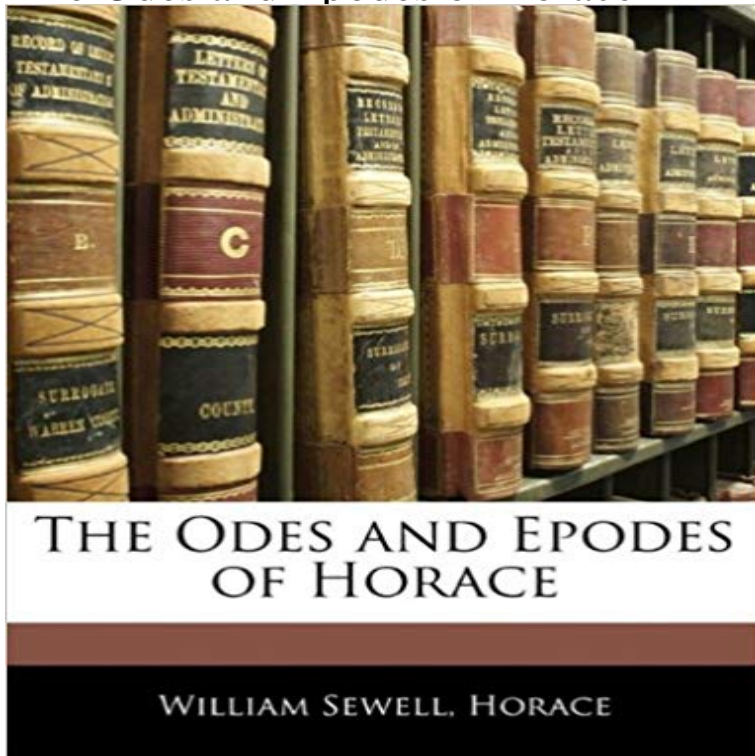


The Odes and Epodes of Horace
