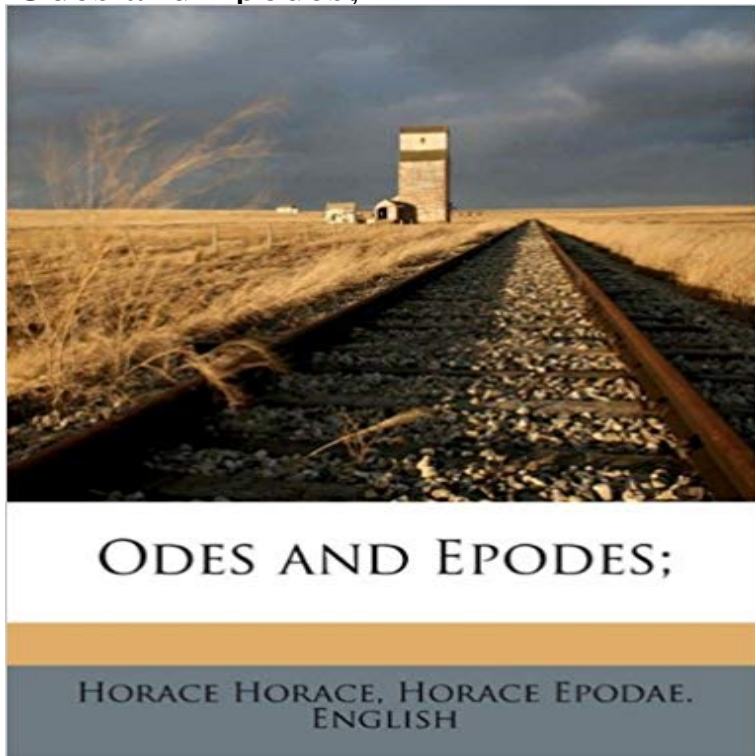


Odes and Epodes;
