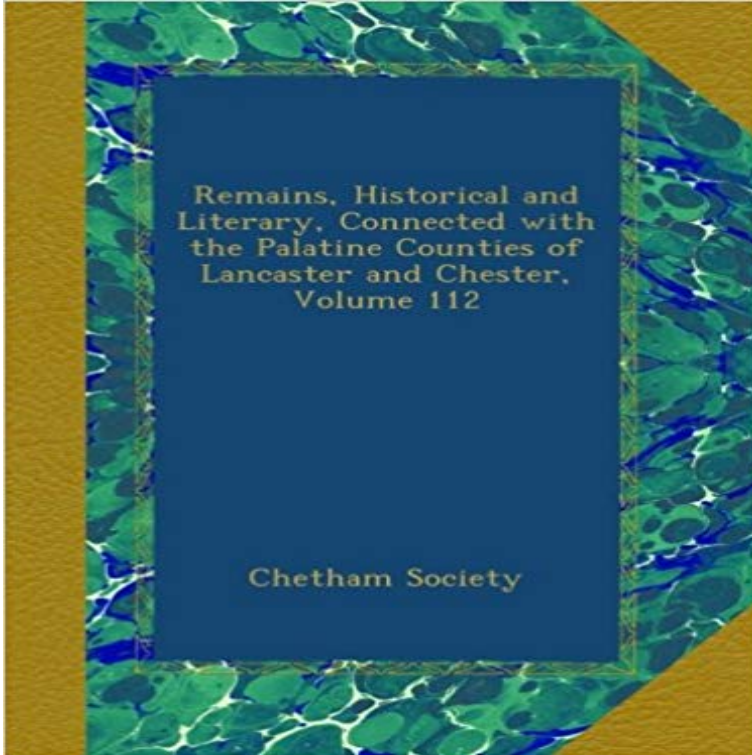


Remains, Historical and Literary, Connected with the Palatine Counties of Lancaster and Chester, Volume 112
