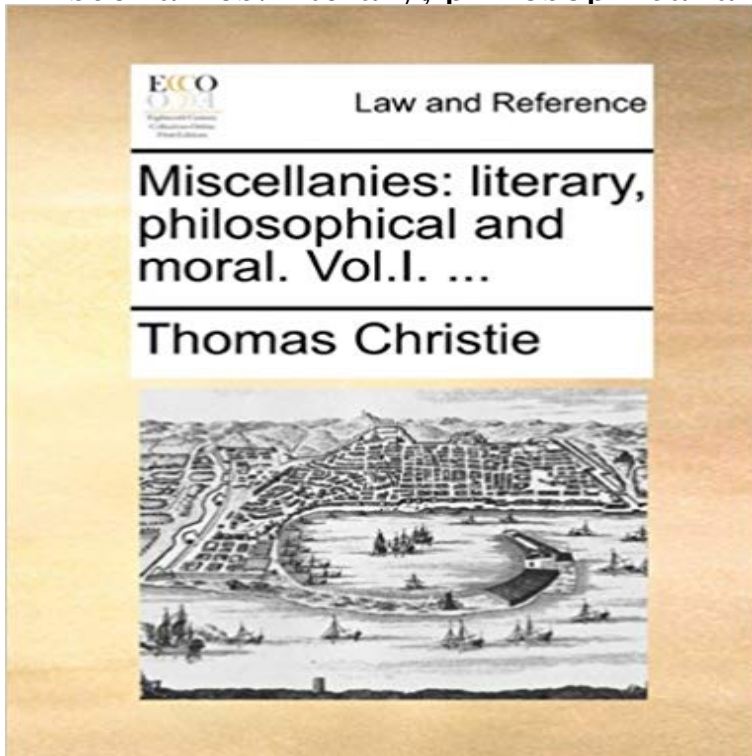


Miscellanies: literary, philosophical and moral. Vol.I. ...
